### The Way Up Is Down (3)

*The Covenant for the Meek*

#### Numbers 12:3-8 (KJV)

*"Now the man Moses was very meek above all the men which were upon the face of the earth. And the Lord came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood in the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam, and they both came forth. And He said My servant Moses...is faithful in all my house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently..."*

#### 1. The Attitude of Meekness...

- a. Become OBEDIENT to Gods will...
- b. STRIP yourself of your privileges and rightful dignity...
- c. Put on the heart of a SERVANT...
- d. LOWER or REDUCE yourself in your own eyes and estimation...
- e. STOOP below your place of recognition...
- f. Declare: "I am a SERVANT of GOD and a SERVANT of MAN"...

#### 2. Guided by Meekness...Psalm 25:1-5 (KJV)...

- a. PLACE your expectation and confidence in God and not in yourself...
- b. Strive to KNOW and TRUST Gods ways, not your own...
- c. God's way is the RIGHT way, SUBMIT to it...
- d. Your way leads to DESTRUCTION, abandon it...**Proverbs 14:12 (KJV); 16:25 (KJV)...**
- e. The high and lofty cannot be guided by God, because they refuse to forfeit their way...
- a. Understand that your way WILL NOT WORK...

### 3. Stay Teachable...Psalm 25:9-14 (KJV)...

- a. When you are EAGER TO LEARN, God easily shows you the way...
- b. Divine guidance comes quickly to those who are teachable...
- c. The meek pay CAREFUL ATTENTION to the things of God...
- d. God reveals His covenant to those who are teachable...**Psalm 25:14 (KJV)**...
- e. God gives those who are TEACHABLE: deeper perception, greater understanding, and the ability to know and perceive what His will is...**Psalm 25:14 (AMP)**...

### *Suggestions for Open Discussion*

1. *Do you enjoy serving people who are much lower than you or equal to you? Can you remember any such experience in the recent past? Did you do it with a pleasant attitude or was it challenging for you? Who is a true servant?*
2. *Read Proverbs 3:3-5 and Proverbs 4:18, 19. Why does Divine guidance flow freely to the meek who trust God? Why do proud people always stumble?*
3. *The meek are leadable, teachable, and not easily irritable. Share a few examples of people in the Bible, and some you know in life who are truly meek. What quality / qualities stand out the most in these people?*
