

CHURCH@HOME NOVEMBER 2016 PRAY THROUGH UNTIL PEACE COMES THROUGH (II)

THE PEACE OF GOD IS PART OF THE INHERITANCE OF THE COVENANT:

(Rom 5:1) Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Jesus gave us His peace.

(Joh 16:33) These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Amp ³³ I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace and confidence. In the world you have tribulation and trials and distress and frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you.]

READ: Is. 9:6, Ph. 4:6-7 KJV, AMP. Col.3:5 KJV, AMP.

- One of the redemptive names of God is Peace. (Is. 9:6).
- Jesus is our peace. Eph. 2:¹⁴ For He is [Himself] our peace (our bond of unity and harmony). He has made us both [Jew and Gentile] one [body], and has broken down (destroyed, abolished) the hostile dividing wall between us,
- We cannot have the Prince of Peace with us and have so much trouble.
- The peace of God is part of the inheritance of the covenant child of God. (Num 25:12, Eze. 34:25, Eze. 37:26).

THREE ESSENTIAL THINGS THAT THE PEACE OF GOD DOES:

- 1. Peace is a garrison- a protective guard around our minds and our hearts. It is a protective covering that prevents any hostile spirit from invading your life. (Ph 4:6-7 KJV, AMP).
- 2. The peace of God is an umpire. Without the peace life can be chaotic. Col 3:15 KJV, AMP.
- 3. Peace is the door opener to the graces of life: The peace of God enables the blessings and favor of God to flow into your life. The peace of God gives you wisdom to make the right decisions.

Now may the Lord of peace Himself grant you His peace (the peace of His kingdom) at all times and in all ways [under all circumstances and conditions, whatever comes]. The Lord [be] with you all (II Thess 3: 16 AMP)
