GLORY (III)

READ: Ps. 62:1-2, 5-10; Ps. 20:7-8; Ps. 21: 1-7; Pro. 3:5-7&35.

(Jer 17:7) Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

(Jer 17:8) For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

A. TRUST IN GOD.

- When you trust the Lord regardless of the uncertainties and the instabilities of the times, you will always manifest His glory.
- The enemy is in the business of creating challenges and situation that will test your faith but you have to keep your focus on God.
- Trust not in the arm of flesh. Be confident in God.(Ps. 20:7-8)
- When we acknowledge God in all our ways He will direct our path and we will inherit Glory! (Pro. 3:5-7&35)
- You are a candidate for shame if your mind is devising your own way. We limit God when we lean on our own understanding.
- Don't abort the Glory; give God a chance to bless you and fulfill His word in your life.

A. ALWAYS SEEK GOD FOR EVERY SITUATION. Pro. 16:1 (Amp) 1 Ch 14:8-17

- When you deal with challenging issues always inquire of the Lord before you act. (1Ch 14:8-17)
- When we commit our thoughts unto the Lord He cause our thoughts to line up with His plan and our plan will be established and succeed.
